**Australian technology company Coretrack said today that Halliburton/DBS and Baker-Hughes/Inteq are assisting the company in developing its patented core-drilling technology for oil and gas.**

Coretrack said it is working with the two services majors to design and test various aspects of the Core Level Recorder System (CLRS) to ensure the system's compatibility with their coring assemblies.

Coretrack managing director Nanne van 't Riet said "crucial CLRS components have already been tested successfully within either operating wells or in surface tests, but with such a high temperature and high-pressure environment, it is imperative that we subject all this equipment to the most rigorous conditions it is likely to encounter in the field."
