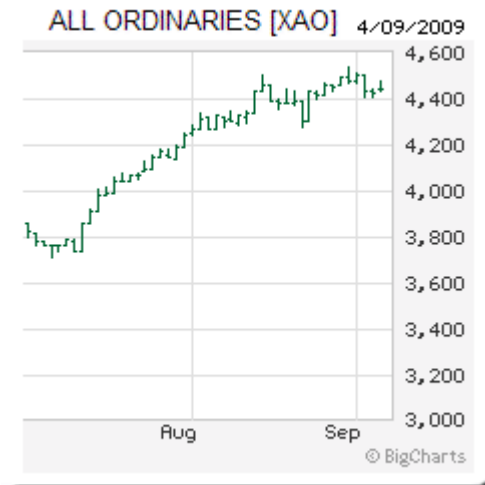
Weekly Market Outlook

The Dow finished 99 points, or 1% higher on Friday, while the S&P 500 advanced 1.3% and the Nasdaq gained 1.8%.

Friday night was all about the jobs data, and while it came in far from perfect, investors were relieved that a smaller-than-expected August job cuts figure was produced. The US Labor Department reported 216,000 less jobs in August, the smallest number of job cuts since August 2008. Despite the better than expected result the unemployment rate hit a 26-year high and now sits at 9.7%.

The day's run still wasn't enough to keep all three indexes from ending the week lower after stocks tumbled in the first three sessions of the week. For the week, the Dow was down 1.1%, the S&P 500 gave up 1.2% and the Nasdaq was 0.5% lower.
